Networking

These networks organise events, conferences and/or workshops, either in English, French or both. Visit the sites to find out more about them and most will allow you to attend as a visitor before subscribing to them.

TIP: Networking can be frustrating if you are not targeting your networking actions. Get started with the ones that seem the most relevant to you. Do you want to know many people across a variety of fields or do you want to dive deeper into your specialization's network?

<u>International Link</u> The Vaud Chamber of commerce supports the integration of the international community in the Swiss business environment.

<u>Nyon Business Forum</u> A Bilingual English-French network facilitating the integration of the two business communities in the Nyon area.

Recruitment agencies

TIP: If you work with many agencies, be transparent with where you applied and keep track for yourself which agency has sent your file where so you can follow up properly.

Job search engines

These are some of the most common job search portals. It's also interesting to track companies and visit their company page career section from time to time. Not all offers are systematically published on one of these portals.

TIP: Most search engines offer the option to send you notifications. There is also the option to make your profile "searchable" within some (like Jobup), this allows companies to search the database of candidates even if they have not published an ad.
